

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence modifications to the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW)*:

- (a) to enable the Civil and Administrative Tribunal to make prohibition orders against former registered health practitioners, and
- (b) to ensure that, in calculating the maximum consecutive terms of office that a member of a Council for a health profession may serve, a period in office resulting from the operation of a certain transitional provision is not counted.
