Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Passenger Transport Regulation 2007* to repeal a provision relating to service contracts for buses (these matters will now be dealt with under the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*) and a redundant provision relating to ferries.

This Regulation is made under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*, including section 63 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Passenger Transport Amendment (Service Contracts Repeal) Regulation 2016.
