

Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2016

Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, with minor amendments, the provisions of the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2011*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2016 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

This Regulation makes provision with respect to prescribing Central Coast Stadium, Wollongong Stadium, Newcastle Stadium and Parramatta Stadium as designated sporting venues for the purposes of the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003*.

This Regulation is made under the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003*, including section 3 and 15 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act* 1989, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2016

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2016.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation repeals and replaces the *Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2011*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2016 by section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the Sporting Venues (Invasions) Act 2003.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Designated sporting venues

The following are prescribed as designated sporting venues for the purposes of the Act:

- (a) Central Coast Stadium at Dane Drive, Gosford,
- (b) Wollongong Stadium at Harbour Street, Wollongong,
- (c) Newcastle Stadium at Turton Road, Broadmeadow,
- (d) Parramatta Stadium at O'Connell Street, Parramatta.

5 Repeal and savings

- (1) The Sporting Venues (Invasions) Regulation 2011 is repealed.
- (2) Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Sporting Venues* (*Invasions*) Regulation 2011, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.
