Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Public Finance and Audit Regulation 2015* to prescribe the Legal Services Council and the Commissioner for Uniform Legal Services Regulation (under Parts 8.2 and 8.3 of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)*, respectively) as statutory bodies that may be audited by the Auditor-General under section 45 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*, including sections 44 (1) (a) and 64 (the general regulation-making power).
