## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Rule is to amend the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* to extend the circumstances in which a cost assessor's certificate must be accompanied by an affidavit.

### **1 Name of Rule**

This Rule is the *Uniform Civil Procedure (Amendment No 79) Rule 2016*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Rule commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005**

#### **(1) Rule 36.10 Filing of cost assessors' certificates**

Omit rule 36.10 (3). Insert instead:

- (3) The certificate or certificates must be accompanied by an affidavit, sworn not more than 14 days before the certificate or certificates are filed, stating:
  - (a) if some of the costs specified in the certificate or certificates have been paid—the amount of the costs that have been paid, or
  - (b) that none of the costs specified in the certificate or certificates have been paid.

#### **(2) Rule 36.10, note**

Omit the note. Insert instead:

**Note.** The certificate or certificates will, from the date of filing, be taken to be a judgment of the court under the legal costs legislation (as defined in section 3A of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014*) for the amount of costs that have not been paid.
