I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (2) of the *Regulatory and Other Legislation (Amendments and Repeals) Act 2016*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 28 April 2017 as the day on which the uncommenced provisions of Schedule 2.4 and the uncommenced portion of Schedule 3 commence, and
- (b) 1 July 2017 as the day on which Schedule 2.3 commences.

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Regulatory Reform and Other Legislation (Amendments and Repeals) Act 2016* that:

- (a) repeal provisions of the *Architects Act 2003*, *Architects Regulation 2012* and *Building Professionals Act 2005* that require complaints made under those Acts against architects and accreditation holders to be verified by statutory declaration, and
- (b) amend provisions of the *Funeral Funds Act 1979* to exempt friendly societies and Crown cemetery trusts from certain registration and related requirements, and
- (c) amend provisions of the *Fair Trading Act 1987* in relation to the publication of standard retail prices of hydrogen or electricity supplied to motor vehicles.
