Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014*:

- (a) to increase (from \$2,666 to \$2,714) the application fee for the registration of an ART provider, and
 - (b) to increase (from \$1,888 to \$1,921) the annual registration fee payable by a registered ART provider.
- This Regulation is made under the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2007*, including sections 7 (2) and (8) and 71 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014

(1) **Clause 4 Registration application fee: section 7 (2)**

Omit “\$2,666”. Insert instead “\$2,714”.

(2) **Clause 6 Annual registration fee: section 7 (8)**

Omit “\$1,888” from clause 6 (1). Insert instead “\$1,921”.
