# **Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2017**

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* to increase certain application and annual licence fees in relation to the supply of substances included in Schedule 2 to the Poisons List, the wholesale supply of poisons and restricted substances and the manufacture and supply of drugs of addiction.

This Regulation is made under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*, including sections 17 (1) (a1), 24 (1) (f) and 45C (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2017*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008**

#### **(1) Clauses 155 (2) (b) and 159**

Omit “\$80” wherever occurring. Insert instead “\$82”.

#### **(2) Clauses 160 (3) (a), 164 (a), 165 (3) (a) and (4) (b) and 169 (1) (a) and (2) (b)**

#### **(5) Clauses 165 (4) (c) and 169 (2) (c)**

Omit “\$319” wherever occurring. Insert instead “\$325”.
