Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Regulation 2019* to prescribe a class of persons to whom the head of a public sector agency may delegate the exercise of certain functions.

1 Name of regulation

7A Delegation by head of public sector agency—prescribed class of persons

For the Act, section 59ZJ(b), the class of persons who are employed in or by another public sector agency to exercise that agency's functions under the Act is prescribed.
